**Additional Requirements:** One year of specialized experience directly related to the position equivalent for GS-04 level in the Federal service. Education may be substituted for experience as follows: Bachelor's degree in nursing = GS-05

**Licensure Requirements**

Applicant must possess a current license/registration as a professional nurse in a State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or a territory of the United States.

**Additional Requirements:** One year of specialized experience directly related to the position equivalent to at least GS-05 level in the Federal service. Education may be substituted for experience as follows: 1 year graduate nursing = GS-07
