

**OFFICIAL TITLE, SERIES, AND GRADE:
NURSE PRACTITIONER, GS-0610-11**

Summary of Major Duties

The Nurse Practitioner either provides or supervises required nursing care to those who are seriously injured due to a disaster or major emergency. Directs the work of nurses, aides, technicians, and licensed practical nurses.

Minimum Qualifications

Education: Degree or diploma from a professional nursing program approved by the legally designated State accrediting agency at the time the program was completed by the applicant.

Additional Requirements: One year of specialized experience directly related to the position equivalent to at least the GS-09 level in the Federal service; **OR** completion of all requirements for a doctoral degree (Ph.D. or equivalent); **OR** 3 full years of progressively higher level graduate education.

Licensure Requirements

Applicant must possess a current license/registration as a professional nurse practitioner in a State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or a territory of the United States.

SUPERVISORY NURSE SPECIALIST, GS-0610-13**

Summary of Major Duties

Serves as the Head Nurse providing leadership, direction, and supervision of nursing care operations when activated under NDMS. Carries out a full range of administrative duties in the performance of supervisory responsibilities.

Minimum Qualifications

Education: Degree or diploma from a professional nursing program approved by the legally designated State accrediting agency at the time the program was completed by the applicant.

Additional Requirements: One year of specialized experience directly related to the position equivalent to at least the GS-12 level in the Federal service. Supervisory experience is required.

Licensure Requirements

Applicant must possess a current license/registration as a professional nurse in a State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or a territory of the United States.
